Worship

As you are aware, Fr Michael Humble is still away from the parish at this time. Winter clothing

Can I please ask that all children are sent to school with a warm coat and accessories (fully labelled with names) to help keep them warm and dry in this freezing weather! Children are allowed to wear black boots in school during the worst weather, as long as they adhere the school uniform policy.

On a note about shoes, too many children are wearing shoes or trainers with colours on them – please ensure that only all black, non-logoed footwear is worn in the future.

PE kits

We still have too many children not wearing the correct PE kit or not bringing in a PE kits at all. PE is a statutory requirement of the National Curriculum and the correct uniform must be worn in line with school guidelines. We do have some spare PE kits in school that will be used by those children who do not being their own kits in – this is washed after each use!
